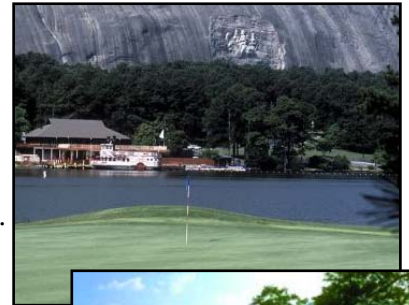

WHO BENEFITS FROM THE YLP CHARITABLE WORKS FUND?
