YCF Mission

The purpose of the Young Constructors Forum is to act as a conduit for participants so they can network, socialize, and exchange ideas about work and the industry. Professional development and leadership skills are high priorities for those involved.

The purpose of YCF is to promote new leadership within the AGC of Kansas chapter in hopes to recruit new board members and leaders of the association.

Officers Terms

YCF has a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman. The term starts as a four-year term for the Vice-Chairman, serving two years in that position prior to becoming Chairman after two years. The Chair and Vice-Chair positions will consist of at least one supplier and one general/specialty contractor member to ensure a balance in leadership. Elections will be held every other year at the AGC of Kansas Annual Convention.

Planning of Events

The year's activities will be determined by the advisory board at the annual convention. A chairperson will be selected for each event and will work with AGC of Kansas staff to help plan their respective event.

Applications & Dues

Beginning January 1, 2006, each YCF member will fill out a membership application for YCF pay an annual fee of \$50. The minimal fee is to help cover costs of events, in hopes to break even during the course of the year.

Participation

It is strongly recommended that each YCF member attend at least two (2) meetings throughout the year. Members must be under the age of 40 to join YCF. However, exceptions will be made for individuals over the age of 40 that express an interest in joining YCF.
