COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

2010 Graduate Scholarship Competition

POSTMARK DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 1, 2009

1. Eligibility

Applicant must be a college senior enrolled in an ABET or ACCE-accredited (or candidate status) construction or civil engineering program, or a person possessing an undergraduate construction or civil engineering degree from such an accredited program. The applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll as a full-time student in a construction graduate degree program or part-time student in one of AGC's recognized master's programs for the Fall Term 2010. **Applicants must also have at least one full academic year remaining as of Fall 2010**, i.e., at least two more semesters. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or documented permanent resident of the United States (i.e., must possess a "permanent resident" card).

2. Requirements

The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items listed below are submitted, as one complete package to the AGC Foundation, postmarked by November 1, 2009.

- a. completed four-page signed application form and attachments/enclosures
- b. **one** evaluation form completed by applicant's college academic advisor
- c. **two** evaluation forms completed by the most recent employers of the applicant
- d. official or unofficial **transcript** of college grades (see Item II.9 of application)
- e. self-addressed/stamped "Notification of Receipt" Postcard

NOTE: Incomplete application packages will not be considered.

3. Award

- a. The scholarship will be in the amount of \$7,500 to be used for the duration of the student's graduate degree program. Installments of the award are to be sent in two payments of \$3,750 each.
- b. Applications will be reviewed and the winner(s) selected by the Board of Directors of the AGC Education and Research Foundation. They will consider the applicant's interest in a construction industry career, undergraduate academic record, extracurricular activities, employment experience, evaluations, and financial need.

- c. All applicants selected as finalists will be subject to a personal interview with a representative of the AGC Education and Research Foundation. Finalists will be notified in February/March 2010.
- d. The award(s) will be announced at the AGC Annual Convention and the winner(s) notified in March 2010.
- e. The initial installment of the award will be sent directly to the student prior to the beginning of the 2010 academic year, with the subsequent installment sent at the beginning of the next academic term. The student's major professor or faculty advisor must transmit a letter to the AGC Foundation immediately following the end of the first academic term, indicating the student's grades and intent to enroll in the following academic term. Checks will not be sent to recipient's college or university.
- f. To receive the initial and subsequent installment, the recipient must forward a copy of grades for his or her most recent term to the AGC Foundation. If the recipient has summer employment, he/she is to provide the Foundation with their basic employment data. Recipients will not be reminded to provide this information; failure to do so will result in disqualification from the scholarship program.
