Construction Defect as Occurrence

Fejes v. Alaska Ins. Co., 984 P.2d 519 (Alaska 1999). The defective installation of a curtain drain resulted in an accident under the insured contractor's CGL policy.

Application of Property Damage Exclusions

Fejes v. Alaska Ins. Co., 984 P.2d 519 (Alaska 1999). Property damage to a septic system due to a curtain drain failure was not excluded from coverage under the insured contractor's policy by the BFPDE exclusion's limitation to that particular part of property, the repair of which was necessary because of the faulty workmanship of the insured.

Alaska Pac. Assur. Co. v. Collins, 794 P.2d 936 (Alaska 1990). The court interpreted and applied the BFPDE work performed exclusion to uphold coverage since the defective excavation and backfilling that caused the property damage was performed by a subcontractor of the insured.
