Construction Defect as Occurrence

Great Divide Ins. Co. v. Bitterroot Timberframes of Wyoming, 2006 WL 3933078 (D. Wy. Oct. 20, 2006). Breach of contract claims against an insured siding installer arising out of defective work and the insured's ceasing operations due to nonpayment did not constitute unforeseeable fortuitous events, but the foreseeable results of the insured's actions, and thus, were not occurrences.

Application of Property Damage Exclusions
