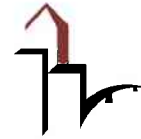

### Tour of the Christopher S. Bond Bridge Project\*

3:30-5:30 p.m., Thursday, September 23

If you can arrive in Kansas City early, please make plans to join us on a very special tour of the new six-lane, cable-stay Christopher S. Bond Bridge over the Missouri River. The center pylon of the new bridge extends 316 feet above the river's surface.

The bridge, scheduled for completion in Fall 2011, is being constructed by Paseo Corridor Constructors, a joint venture partnership of Clarkson Construction Co., Massman Construction Co. and Kiewit Construction. The project was designed by Parsons Transportation Group and TranSystems.

Please be sure to bring your hardhats and wear closed-toe shoes and jobsite-appropriate clothing. Buses to and from the site will be provided.

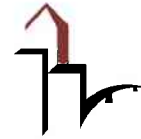
