OVERVIEW

This is also an opportunity for highway & transportation contractors to descend on Capitol Hill to visit members of Congress and advocate for passage of a new transportation authorization bill, transportation infrastructure funding, regulatory reform and protection of the programs they work under.

The Highway and Transportation Forum features meetings with the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Aviation Administration, Federal Transit Administration and Federal Railroad Administration as well as each contractor's members of Congress.
