Military Programs Recovery Act Contract Actions as of Mar 2010

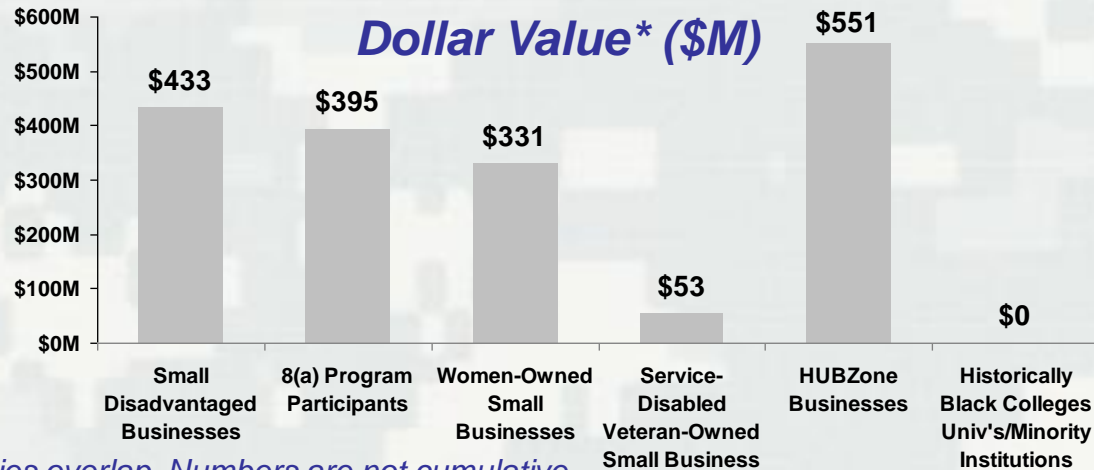
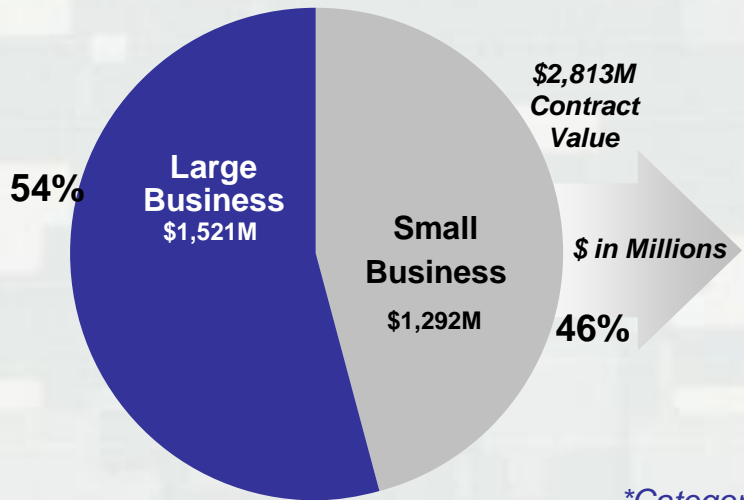
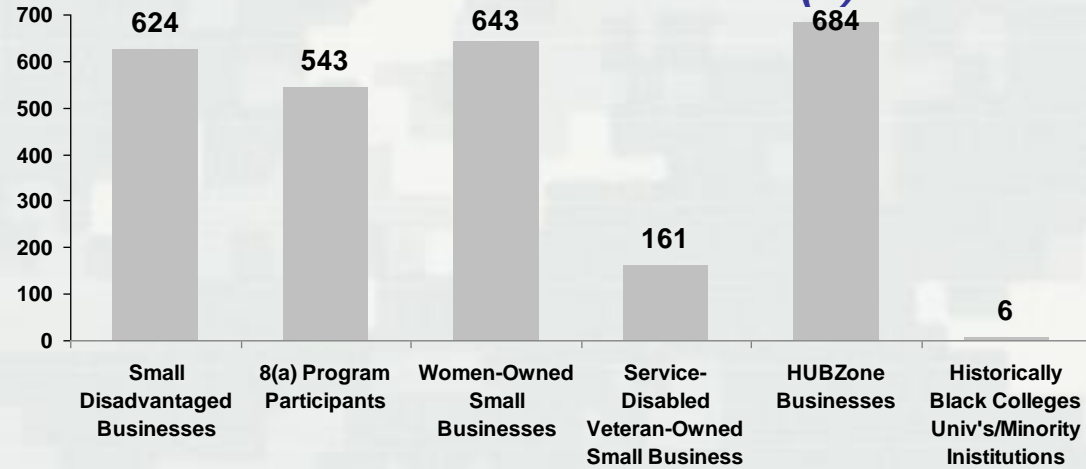
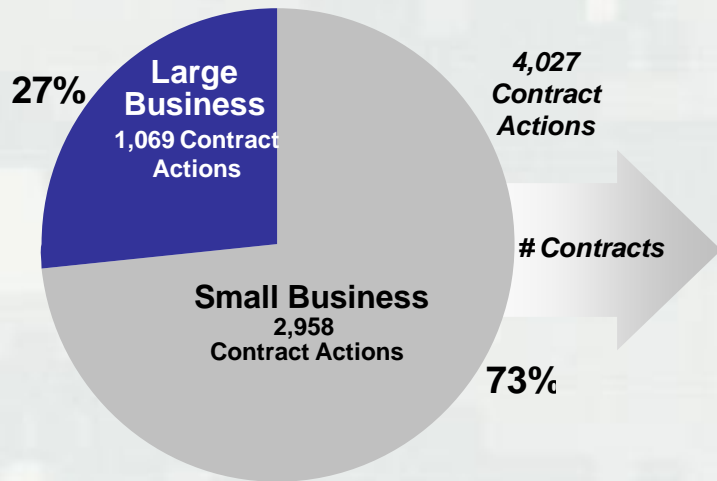
