### NEW POLLING SHOWS WIDESPREAD SUPPORT FOR IMPROVING ROADS AND BRIDGES, HIGHLIGHTS COST OF POOR ROAD CONDITIONS TO MOTORISTS

*Associated General Contractors of America will Release National and 50-State Polling Results, Unveil Campaign Urging Congress to Pass New Highway and Transit Bill During Virtual Media Briefing on Thursday, July 2, at 1 p.m. EDT*

On **Thursday, July 2, at 1 p.m. EDT**, the Associated General Contractors of America will release national and 50-state polling results showing widespread public support for improving roads and bridges during a virtual media briefing. The polling, which was conducted by Morning Consult, will also highlight the costs poor road conditions impose on American motorists. And association officials will unveil details of a new campaign urging Congress to pass new highway and transit legislation.

AGC of America's chief executive officer, Jeff Shoaf, will share the survey's key findings and outline the new campaign. Matt Monday, director of public affairs for Morning Consult, which conducted the polling, will review the survey results and explain the methodology.
