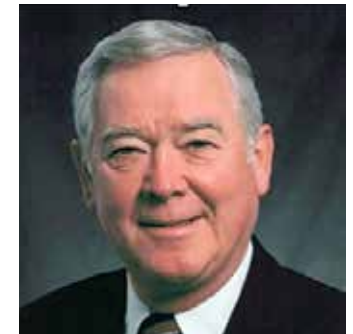

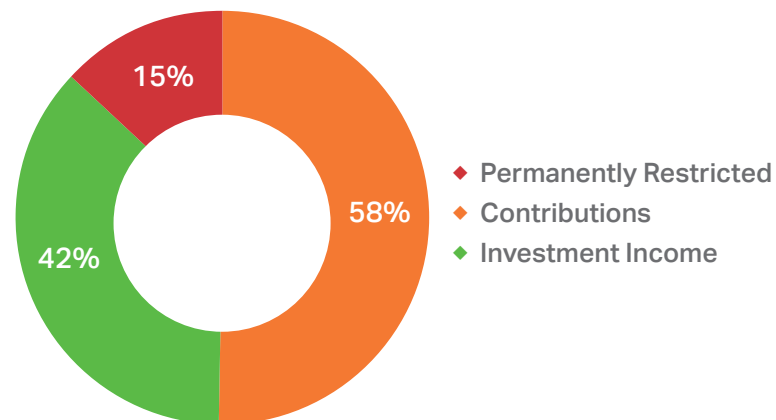

FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

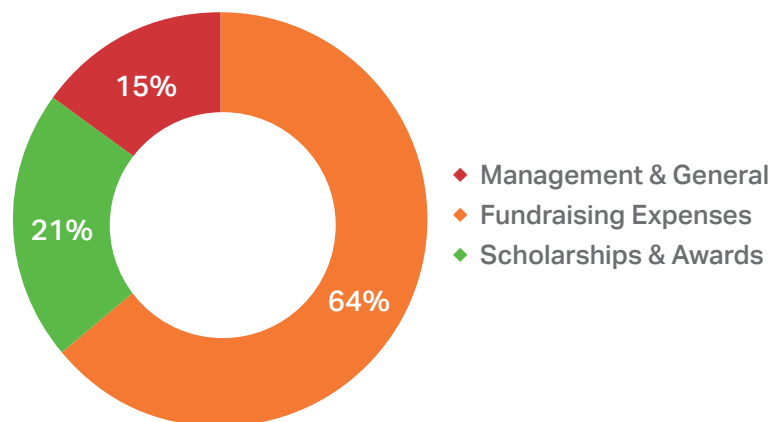
Like most organizations, the AGC Education and Research Foundation dealt with a challenging 2020. Contribution revenue was down from the prior year, but thanks to its very generous donors, the Foundation still raised \$736,000 in total contributions. The Foundation's gala was able to be held just before COVID-19 went full swing in the United States. Despite the lockdowns and business slowdowns caused by the pandemic, the Foundation's investments still had positive returns during the year, and the Foundation ended the year with \$12.16 million in net assets. The Foundation awarded scholarships of approximately \$470,000 in 2020.

The AGC Education and Research Foundation awarded Dr. Eric Showalter, Missouri University of Science and Technology, with the 2020 Outstanding Educator Award.

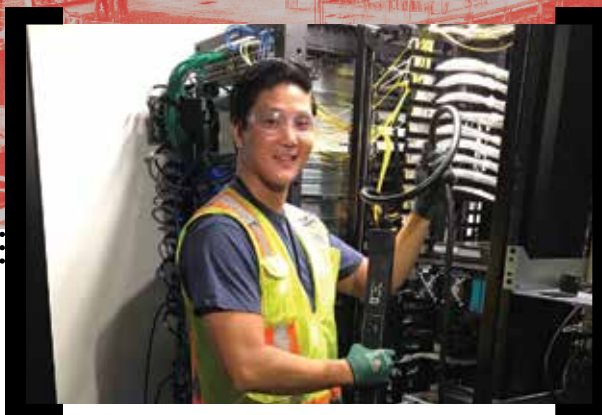

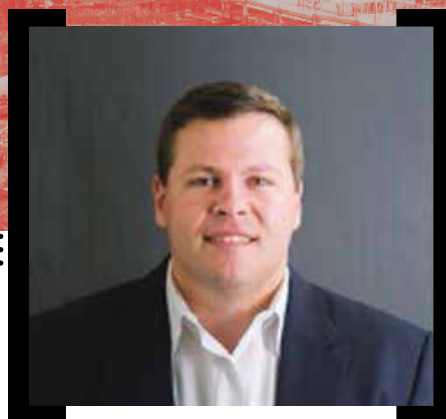
