Council membership has many benefits, including eligibility to participate in the Council's Fall Meeting and all other Council activities, participate in the LELC e-Forum (the Council's e-mail discussion group), receive all Council mailings, receive possible referrals by AGC staff and Council members, and receive a reduced registration fee for the Council's annual Construction Labor Law Symposium.

Council membership now runs on a calendar-year basis. Payments are accepted year-round, but dues will not be pro-rated for payments made mid-year.

Council membership is by individual, not by firm. Each individual desiring membership must submit dues.
