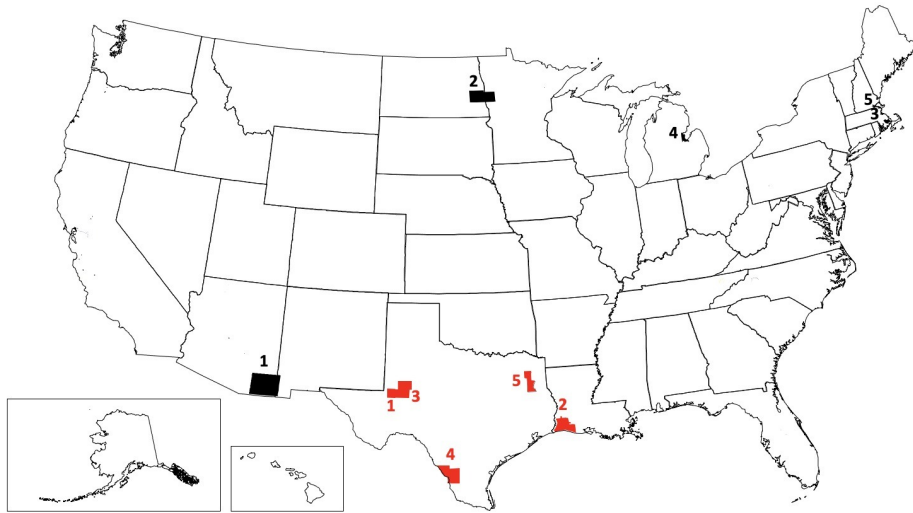


Metro Areas with Largest Percent Changes in Construction Employment, February 2020–April 2021

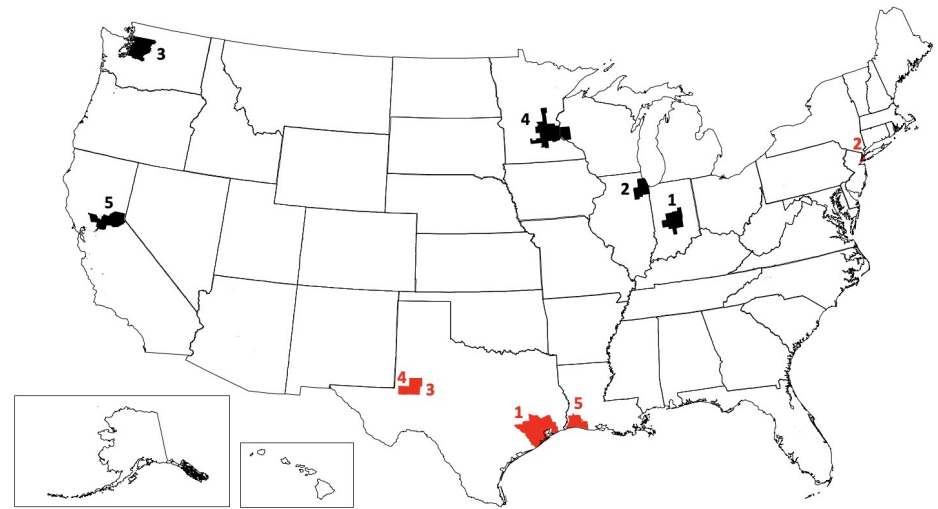
