




#### 2. What percent change do you expect in your headcount in 2023? Responses: 21




### 3. How would you describe your current situation in filling salaried and hourly craft positions? Responses: 21





## 4. Do you expect any changes in the availability of hourly craft or salaried personnel over the coming 12 months? Responses: 21







#### 6. How has your firm responded to supply-chain issues in 2022, if any? (mark all that apply) Responses: 21






9. Did an owner postpone or cancel any projects that were scheduled to start in 2022 or 2023? (mark all that apply) Responses: 21






## 12. What challenges, if any, do you see regarding the safety and health of your firm's workers? (mark all that apply) Responses: 16











17. Does your firm use cloud-hosted technology in any of the following ways (mark all that apply)? Responses: 20
