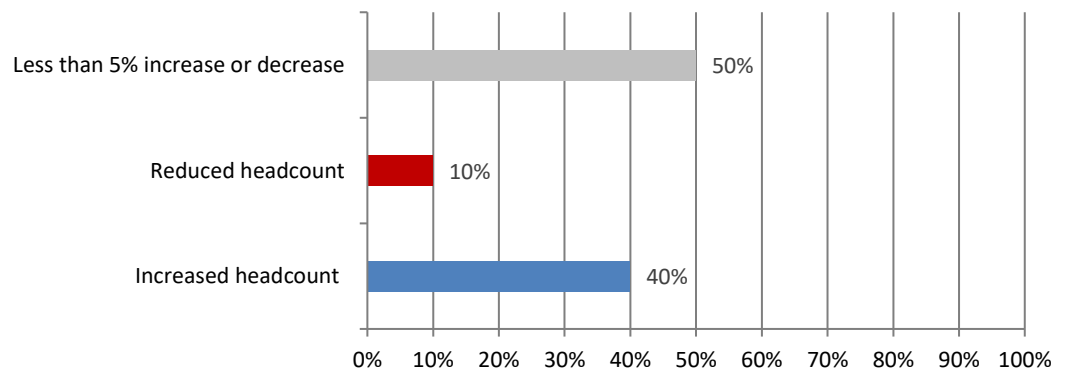

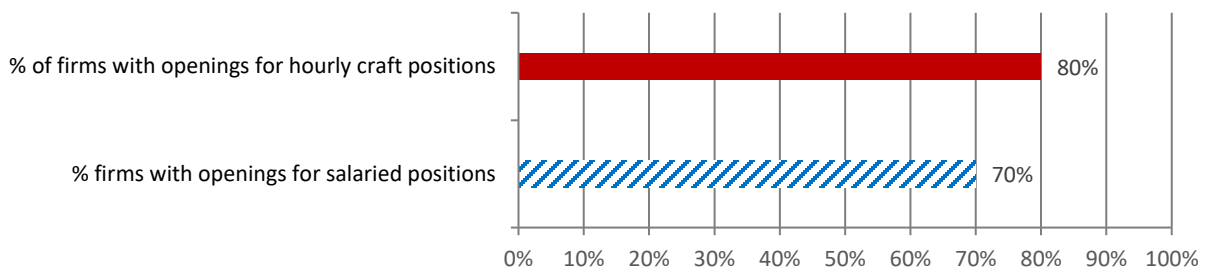

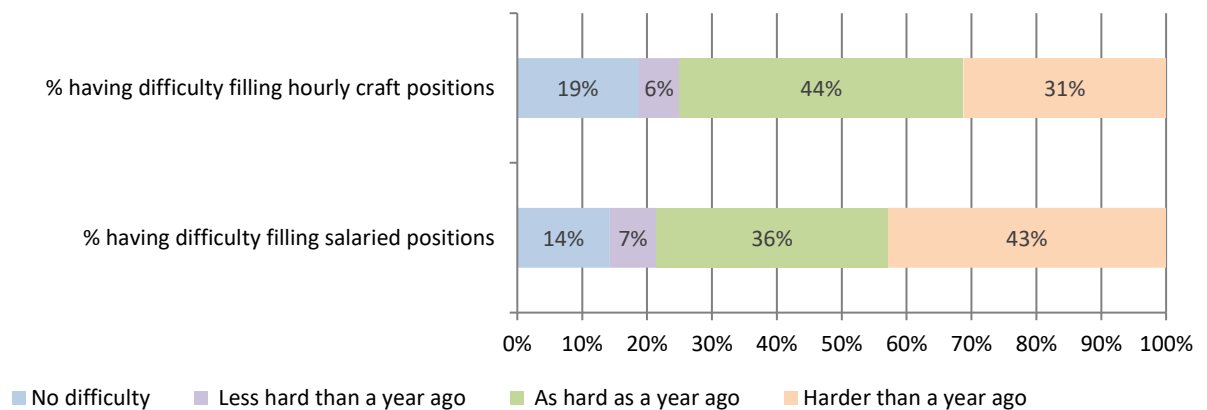
#### 1. By what percentage has your firm's headcount changed in the past 12 months? Responses: 20



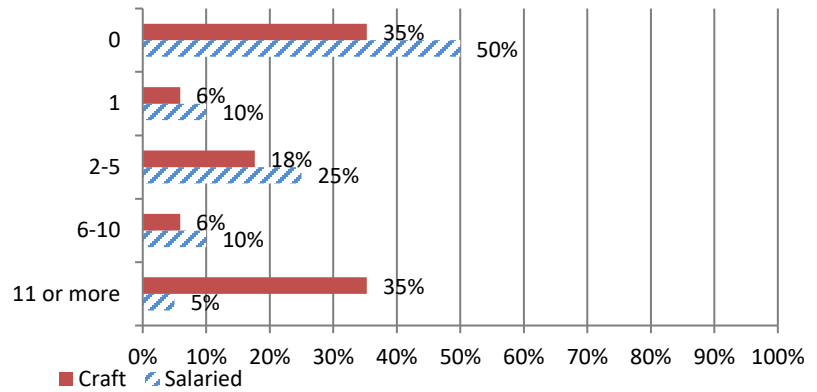
#### 2. Do you currently have an open hourly craft or salaried position? Responses: 20 Salaried; 20 Craft



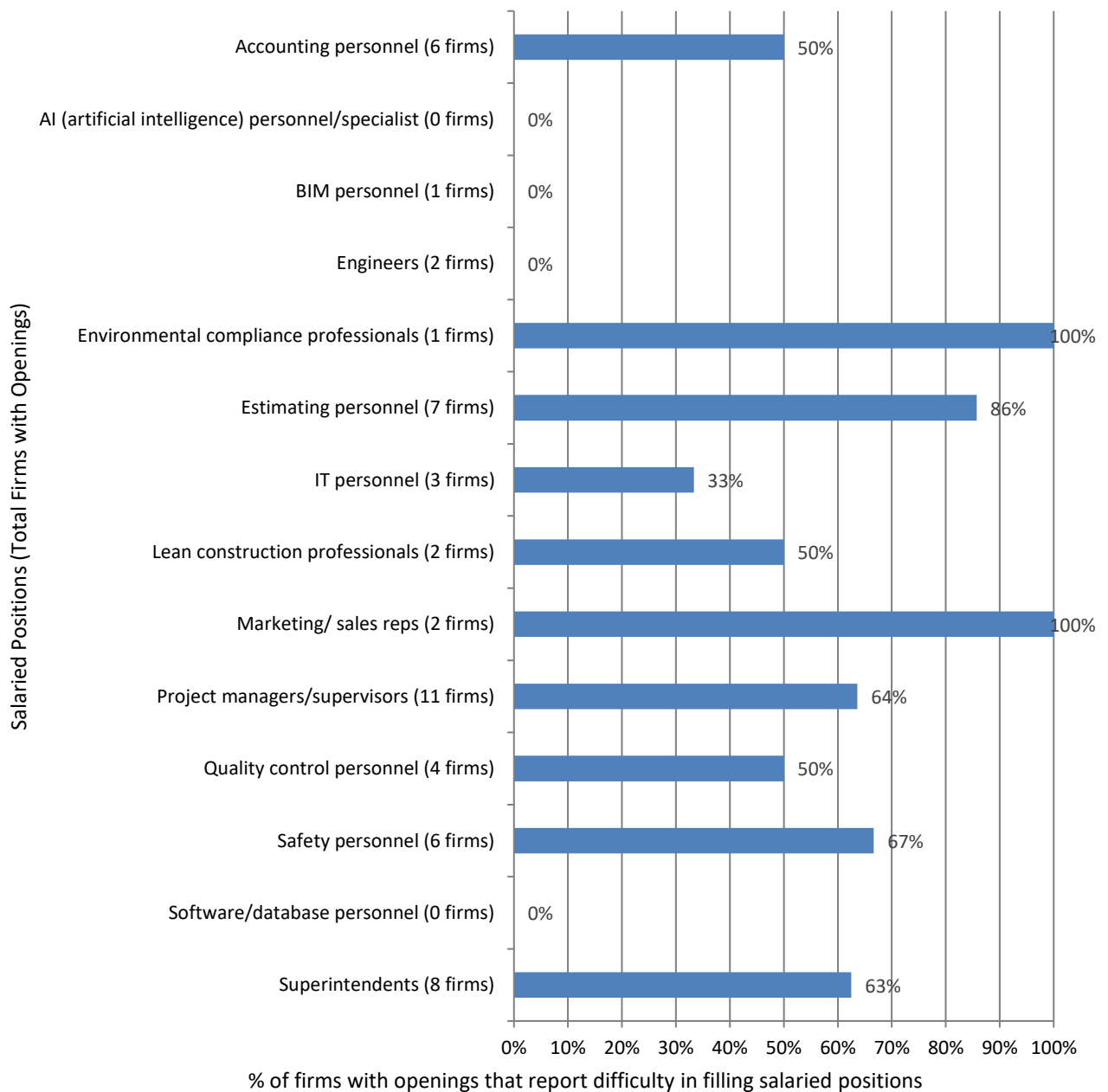

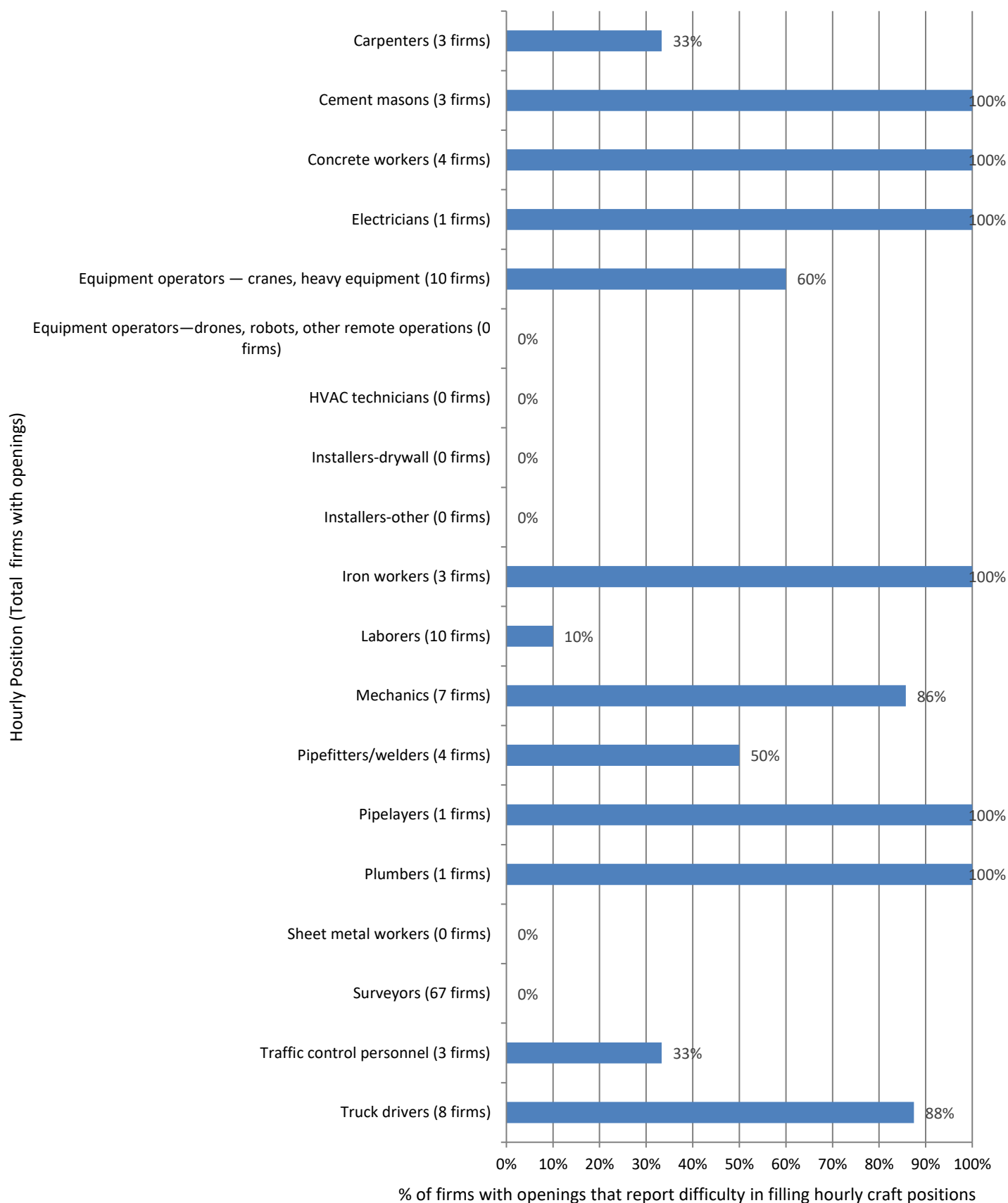

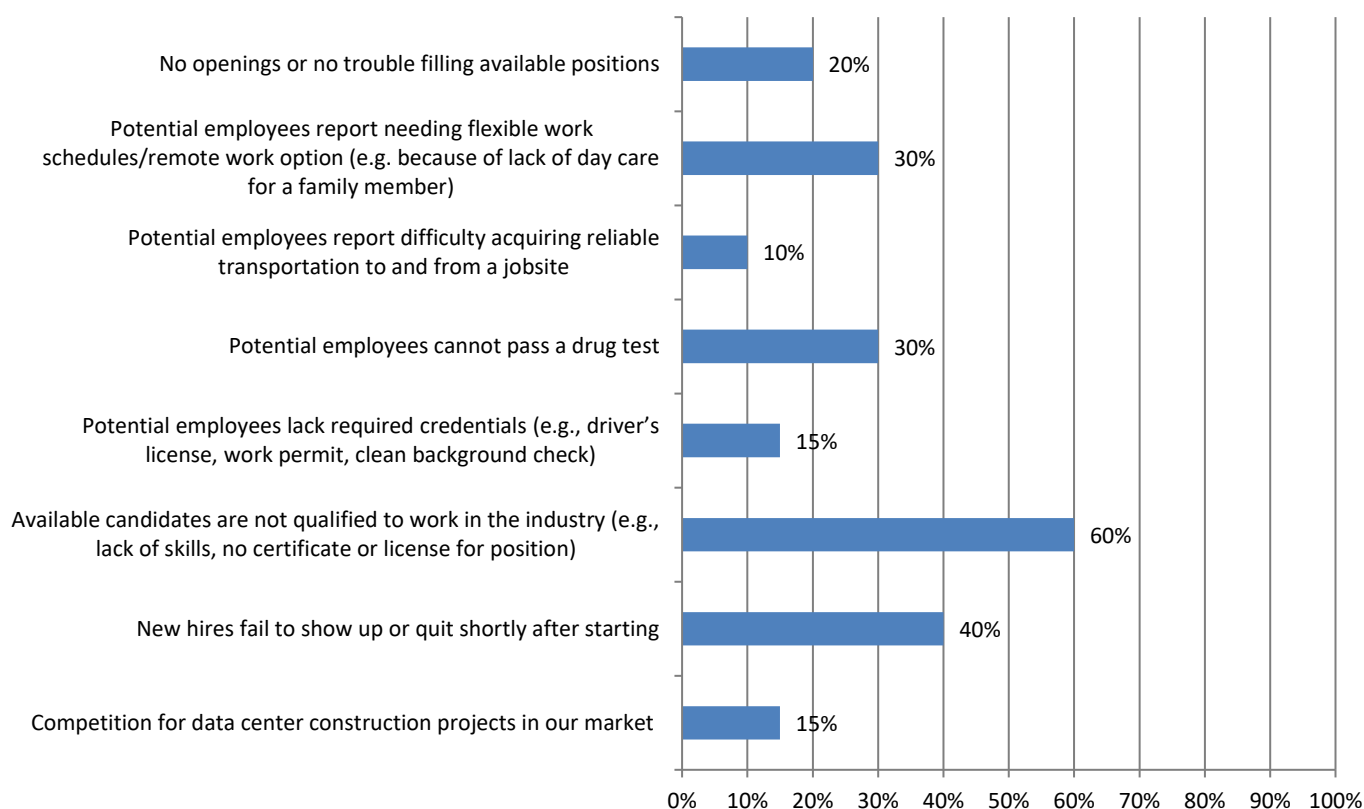

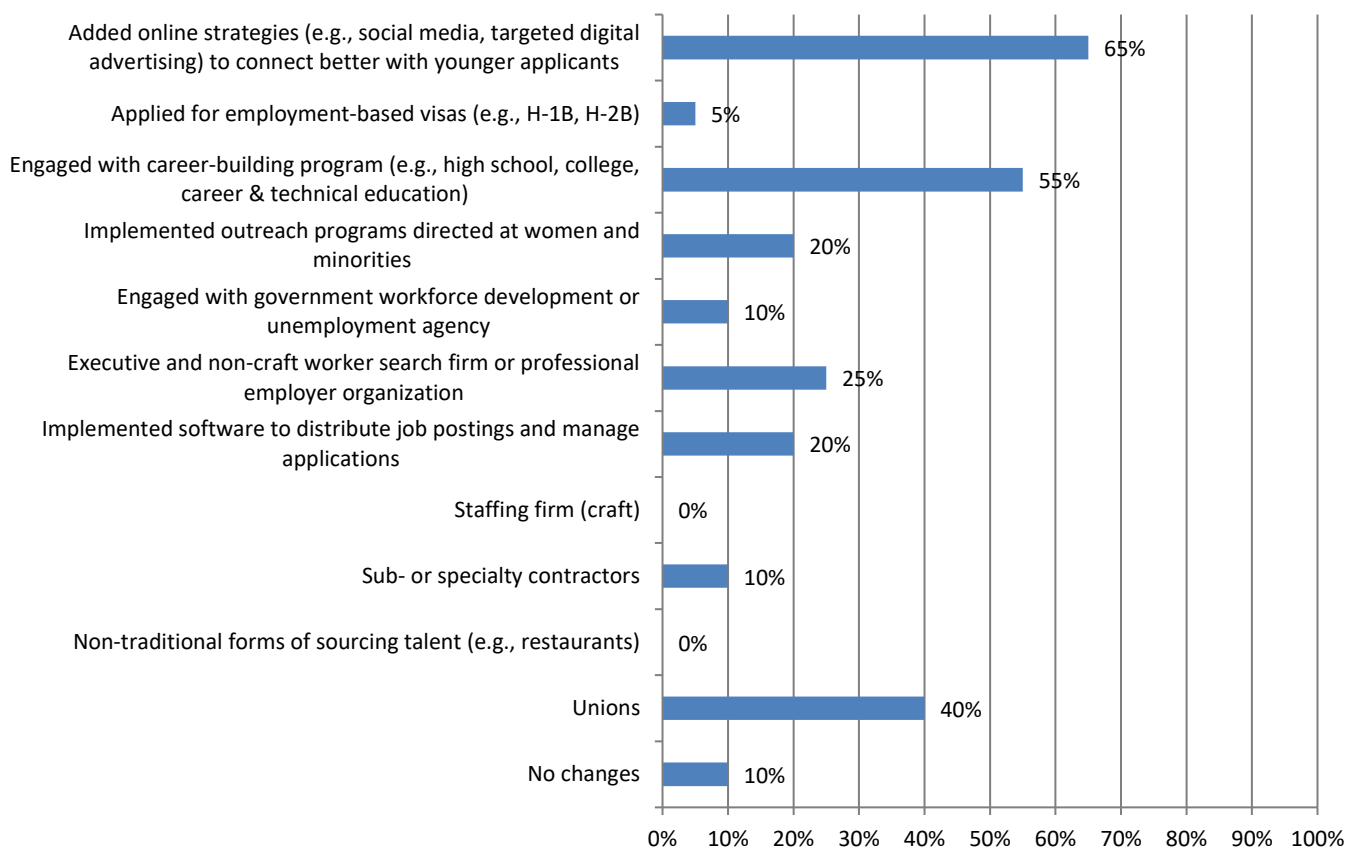

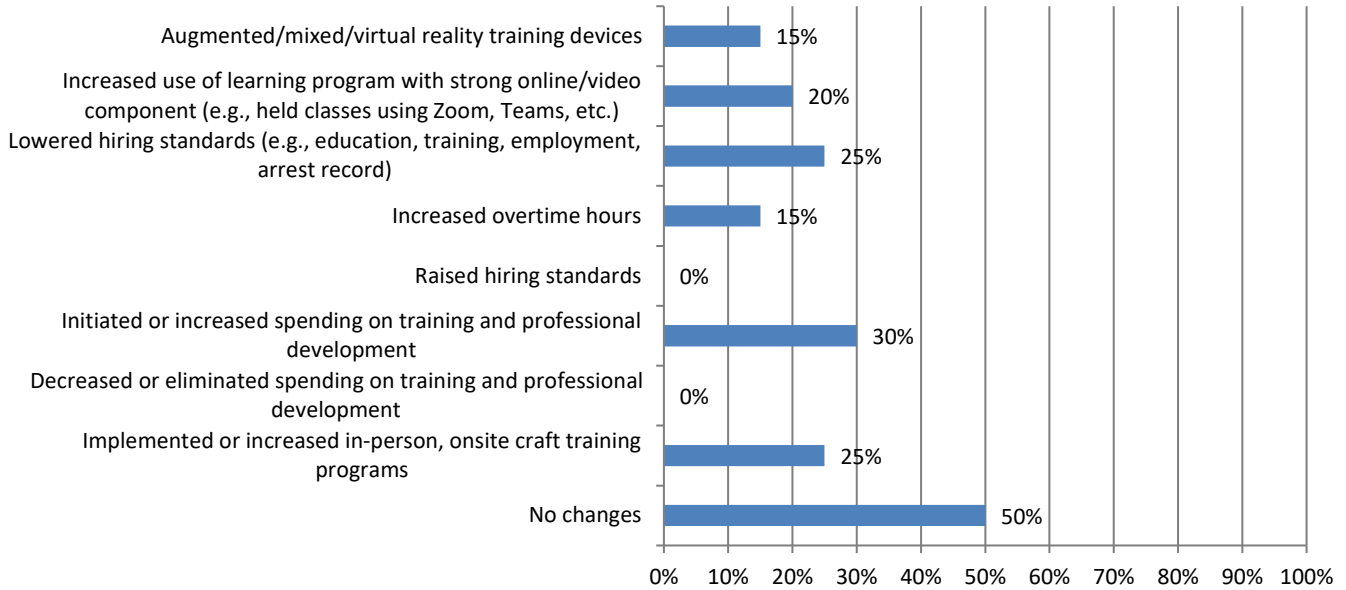

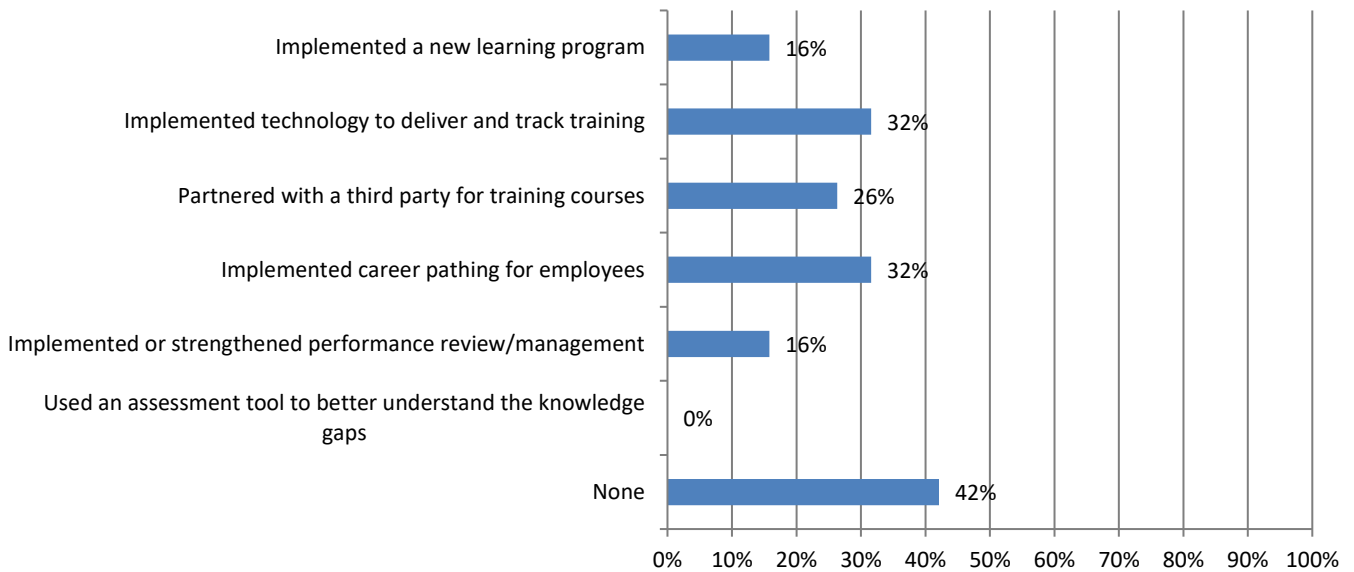

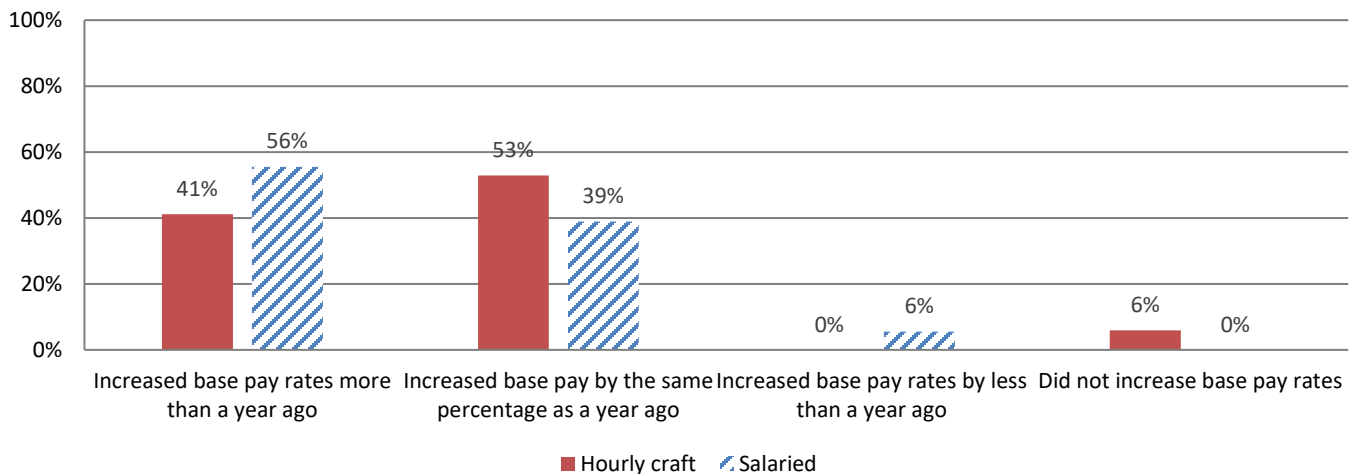

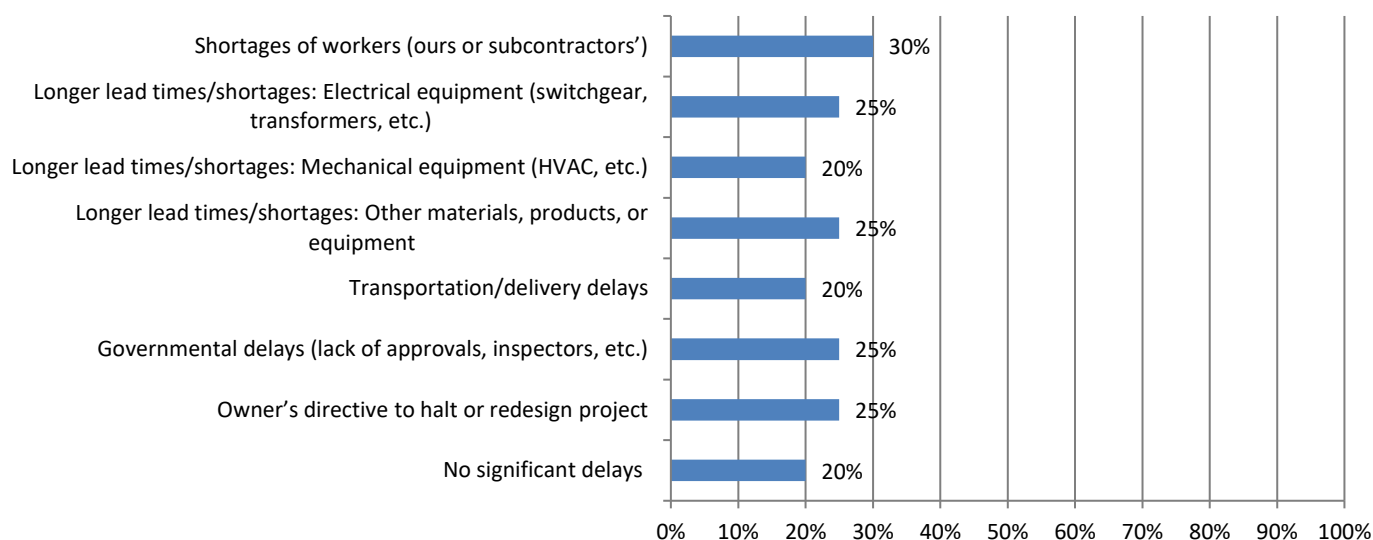

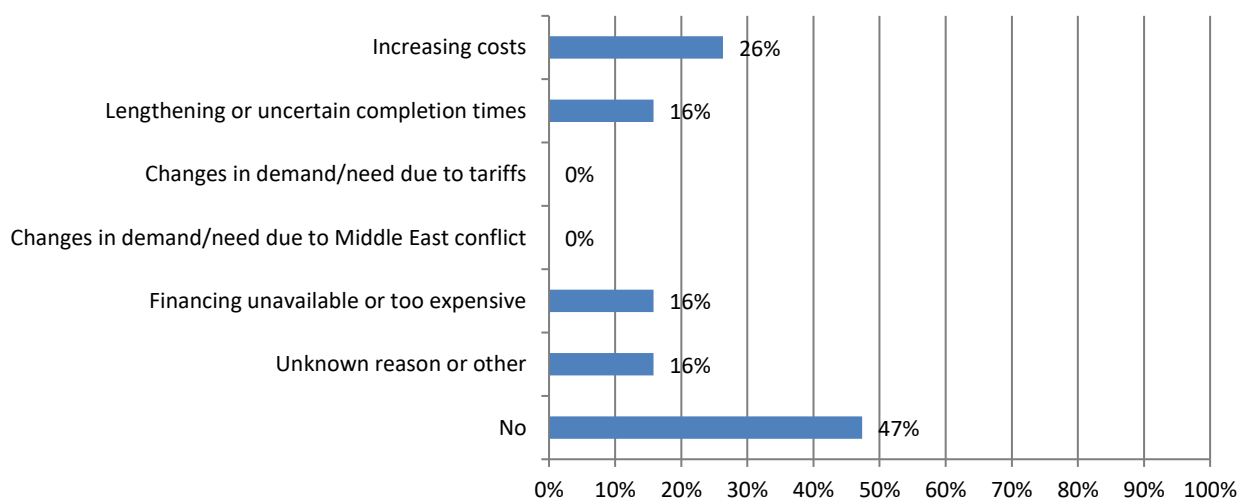

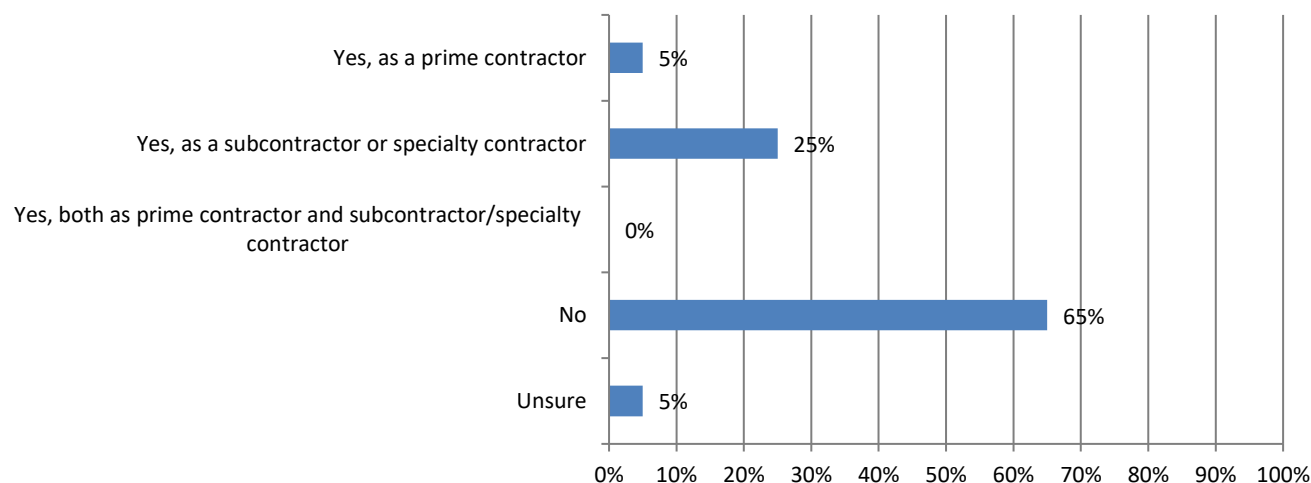

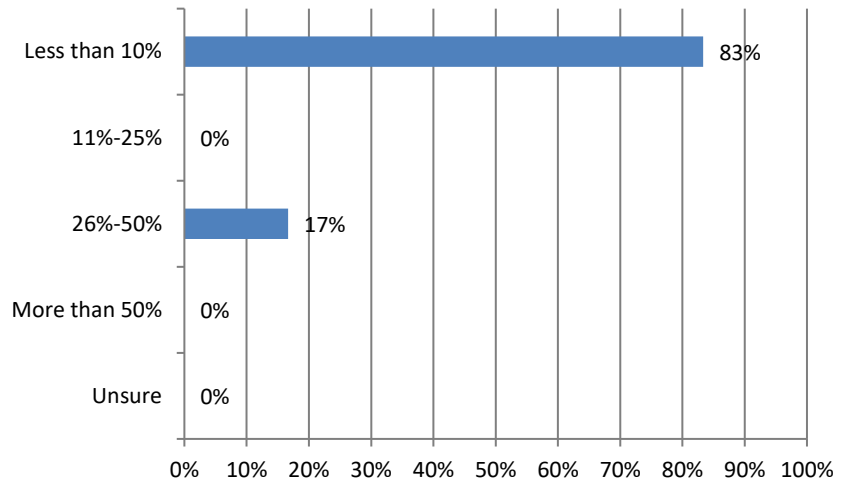

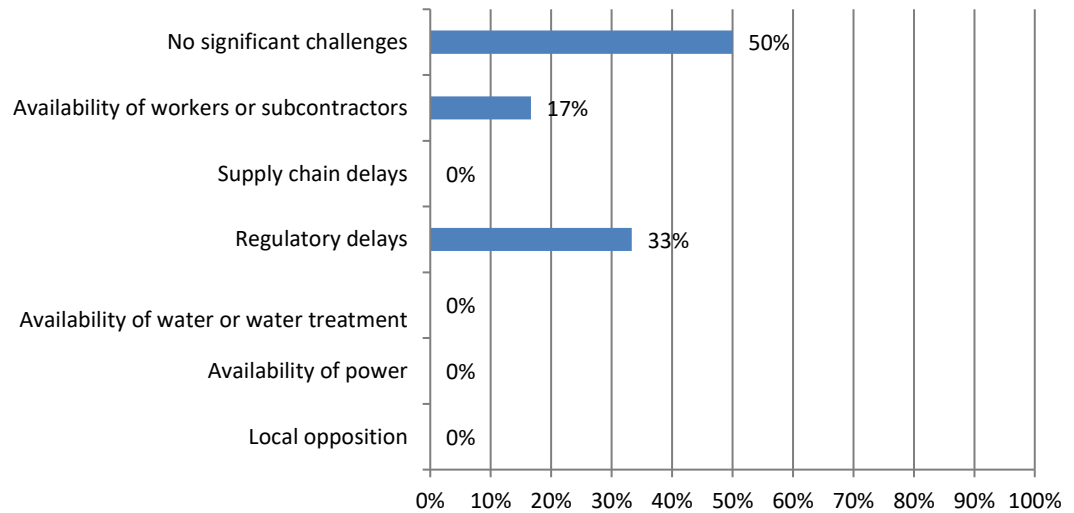

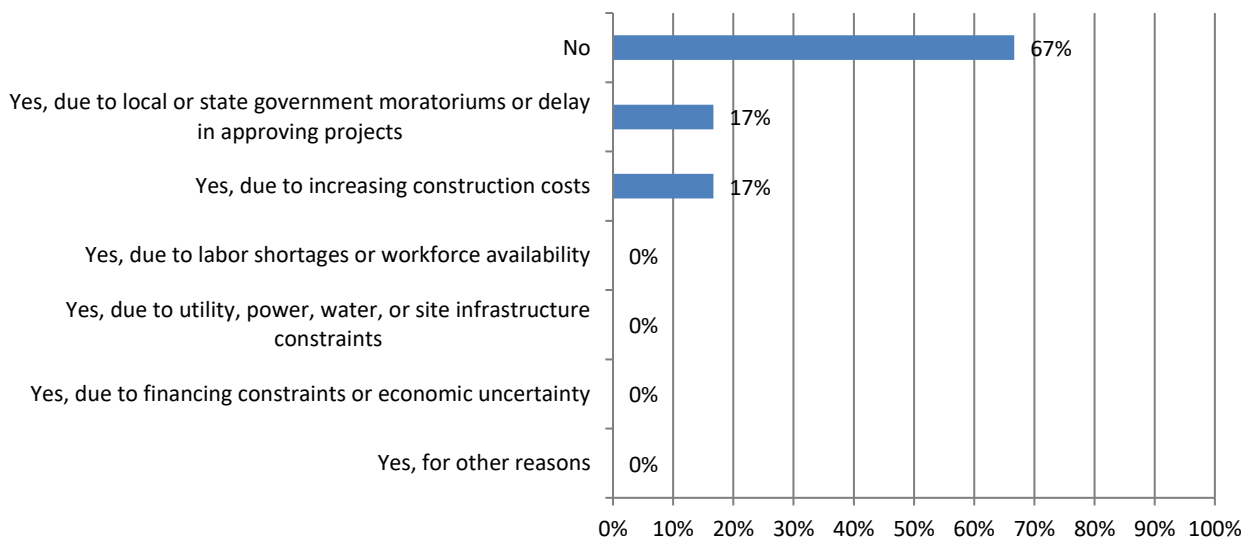

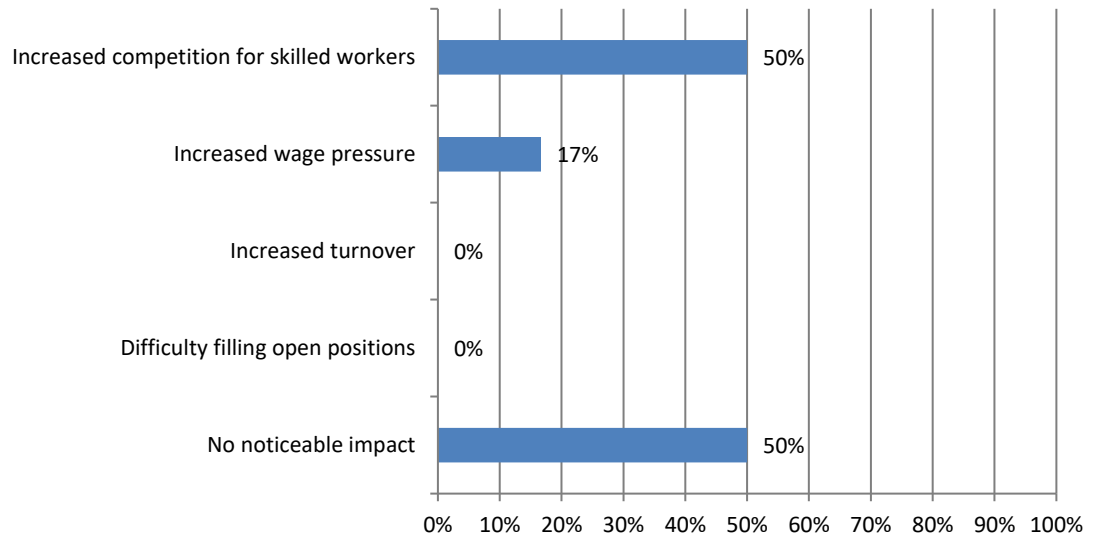

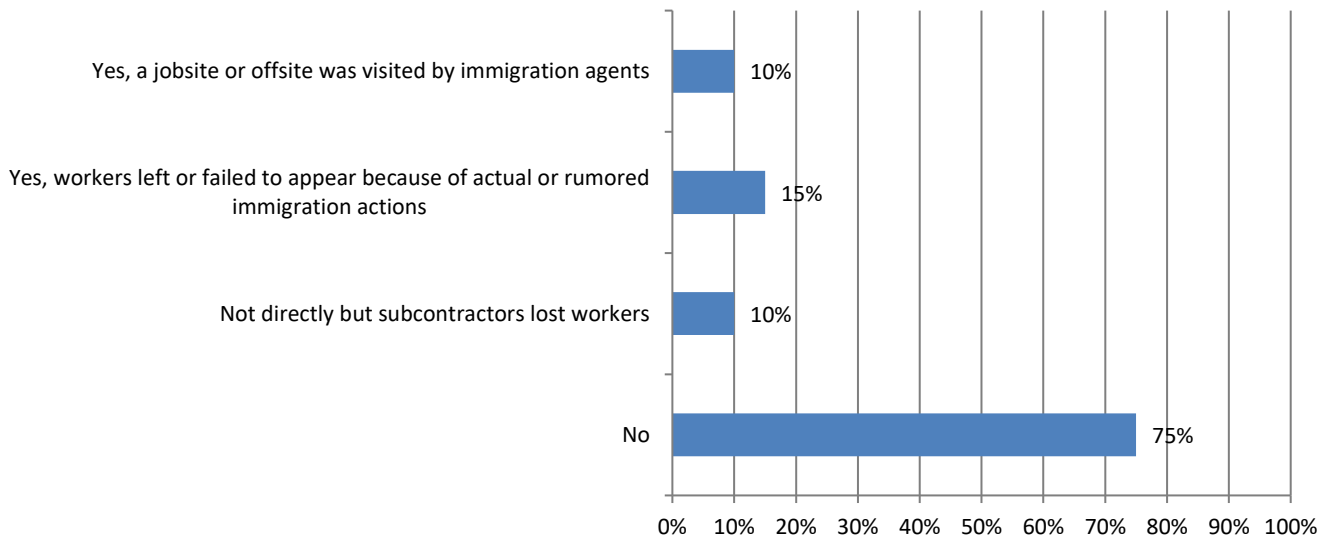

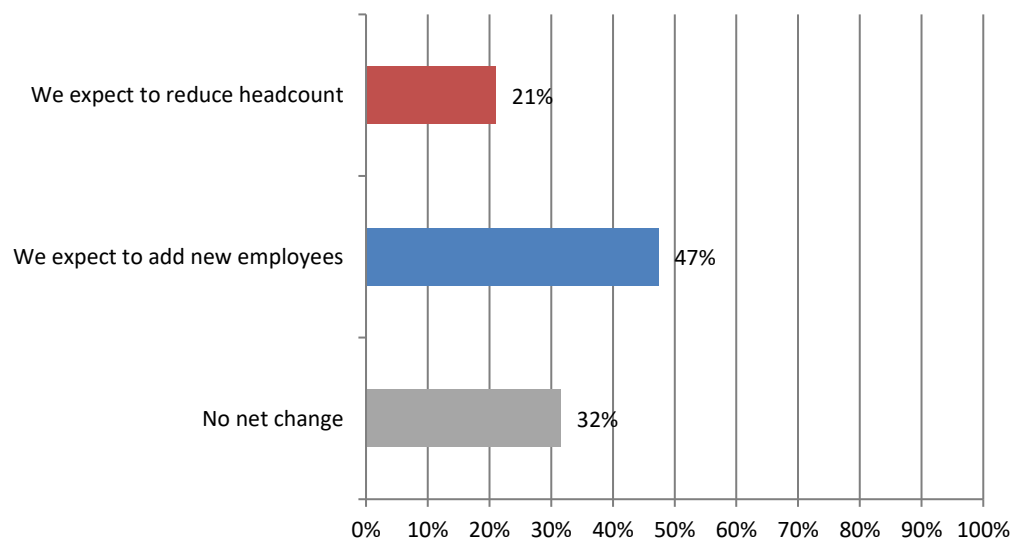

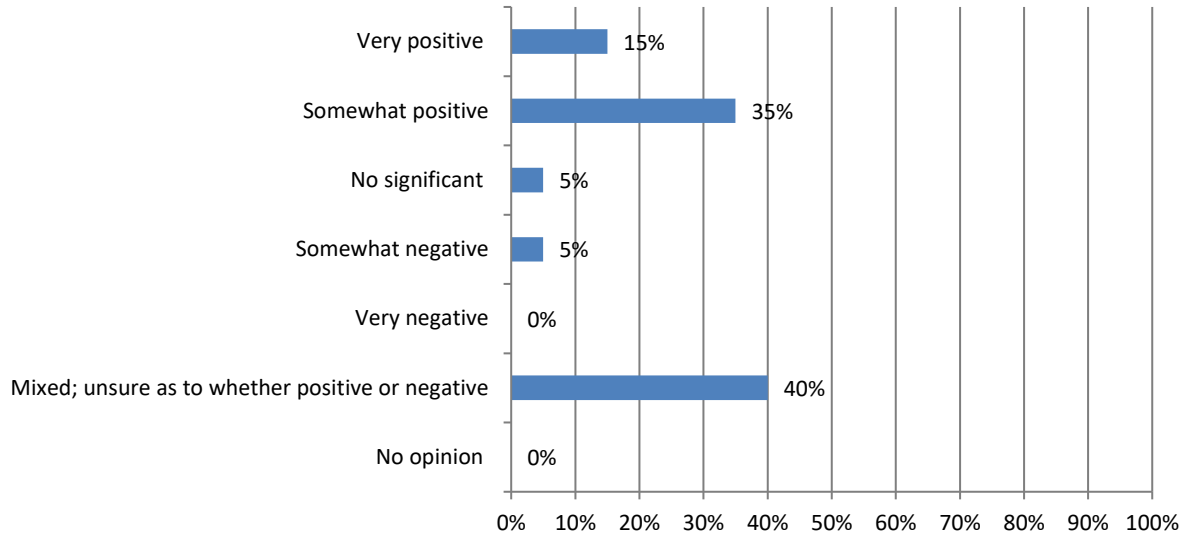

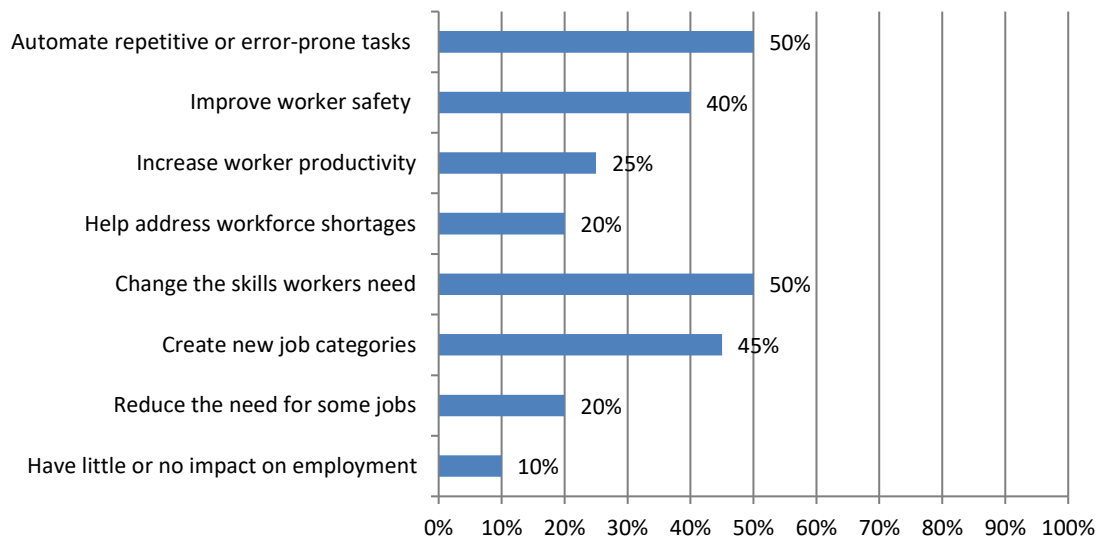

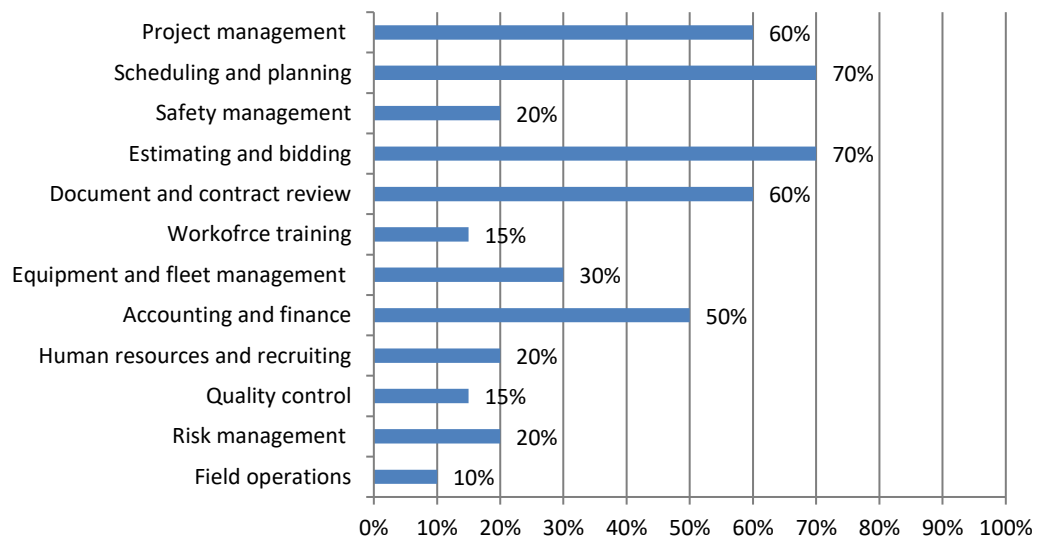

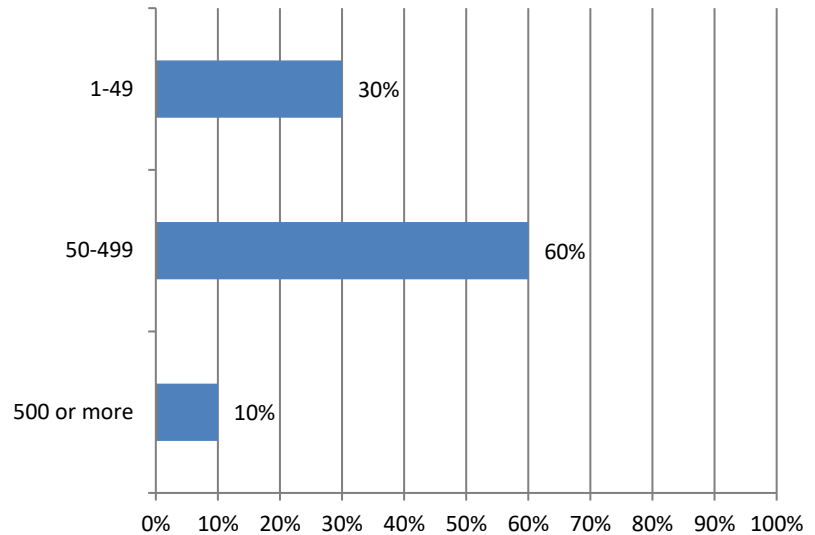

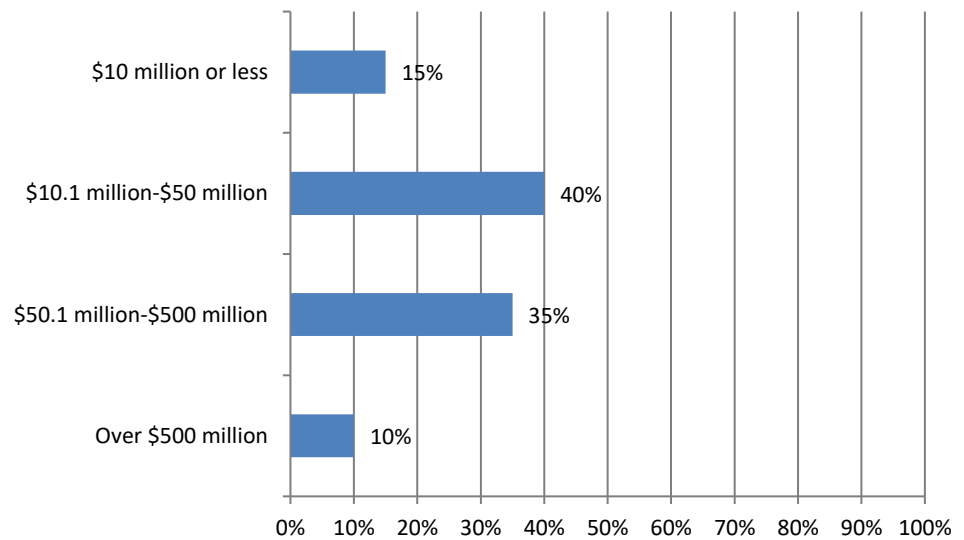

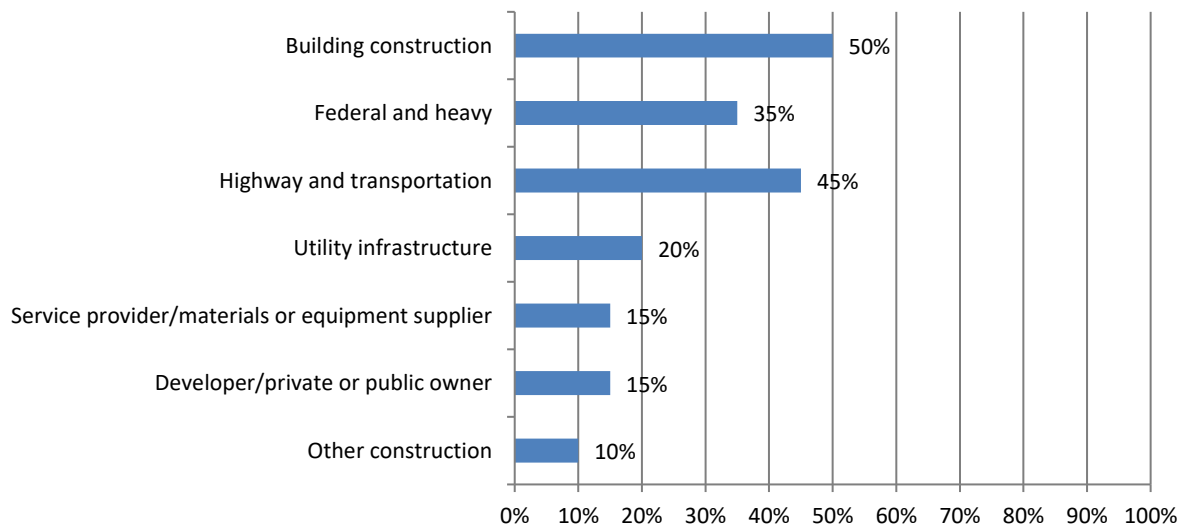
